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Terms and Explanations for *On That Day* and Related Verse

Bus Stop Poetry, LLC, through this document, publicly and freely makes available this imagery poetry artwork that honors and memorializes the eleven victims of the 9/11 attacks who were residents of Montgomery County, Maryland.

The 25th Anniversary Remembrance was held at 9am, September 11, 2026 at Rockville's Courthouse Square Park. This park holds the County's 9/11 Memorial.

Mark Pierzchala attended this and previous annual remembrances. For this work, he took and used pictures from September 11, 12, and 13, 2026 and September 11, 2014.

These works are released through a Creative Commons license. They are held in a pdf document called *On That Day.pdf*. There are three slides of imagery poetry.

The first such slide gives a panoramic view of eleven benches honoring the eleven victims. It contains two short poems *Eleven Benches* and *On That Day*.

The second slide displays a 'from-behind' picture of the benches as if peering over the shoulders of the eleven from their benches. It holds *We Wonder, We Ponder*.

The third slide names the victims and shows images of verse displayed with each of their benches, as well as an image of the large American Flag displayed 9/11/2026. It holds *We Move On*.
